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	<ul> <li>REDCap affordable for non-profit (\$118/mo); Ona Data (no IOS platform – cost more and through a third party) \$2400/yr.</li> <li>Can collect surveys on-line, can enter hard copy surveys via the web, can design surveys, mobile apps, compatible with IOS and android, HIPAA compliant</li> <li>Usability, well established, active partners, flexibility but KMNH would need to submit an application for a license to be approved in order to use the software.</li> <li>Data Committee did meet and review the research from KMNH, PIC uses Survey 1,2,3.</li> <li>Desires a vote now so can move forward as implementing will take some time</li> <li>HMIS Access Policy</li> <li>Getting interests from several organizations to have access to BTG HMIS. Due to previous issue and lack of knowledge of the system, KMNH feels we need to create a better guideline before they granting access. Most organizations don't understand the basic concepts or mistakenly think PIC and BTG run the same. There could possibly be a flow chart, information. We do not have a policy in place now for this and feel this will give basic knowledge and understanding before requesting access. Will continue to work on this with the data committee.</li> <li>Sharon asked if there would be training for organizations or local chapters to take on? Alison stated that still working on this and working with the data committees.</li> <li>Harold: resources that would be available to support any training, other resources that might be available to support this training. 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<ul> <li>6.9 million, (7% for HPO admin, 1% for HMIS) adding in outreach services (up to 2 years) to identify households affected and impacted by wildfires, utilize funds</li> <li>Kauai 1 staff and one vehicle</li> <li>Hawaii 1 staff and one vehicle</li> <li>Maui two staff and two vehicles</li> <li>Contracted with KMNH and CCH to administer the rental assistance program.</li> <li>Rapid re-housing, project based rapid re-housing because there is currently a low housing inventory and expensive driven up rental costs (some of the housing coming up in the near future)</li> <li>Homeless prevention and rapid-rehousing and project based rapid re-housing will be part of this funding</li> <li>May 8 notice for a public hearing regarding the 2nd allocation of funds</li> <li>Sharon asking about data and numbers of families that have been relocated to a neighbor island</li> <li>Harold stating that there are people on Kauai, just had a second person come by. Not sure about the verification of homelessness and if this was going to be expanded, sent to KEO but wasn't able to access services</li> <li>Harold – looking at broadening the scope of homeless verification (previously homeless and in the affected area). There were 400+ people reported by ARC, data quality from ARC and FEMA difficult and hard to decipher. Want to extend to the broadest extent possible.</li> </ul>
